

Incoming Exchange Program - 2017 Spring Semester

Please follow the below instructions and complete the on-line application process.

1. Firstly, the partner university should nominate the exchange students via the on-line nomination system. (The nomination link may differ from each university, partner university coordinator will receive specific link by NCTU coordinator. Once submitted, the partner coordinator will not be able to modify the application documents.)
2. Then, we will send individual link to each qualified student.
3. Students are required to click the link and register the on-line application system, fill all the required column, upload all the necessary documents and submit. (*the on-line process will be done once every document is submitted and students will not be able to modify their applications after submission)

*Required documents for application:

- (1) Application form (with signature)
 - (2) Curriculum vitae (CV)
 - (3) Study Plan (including a tentative list of courses you would like to take; please use the following link <http://timetable.nctu.edu.tw/> for your reference)
 - (4) An original transcript of academic records translated in English or Chinese
 - (5) A copy of student ID card of the home institute (with expiry date).
 - (6) A copy of valid passport
4. **Download and print** the completed application form (signed by the university) + all the other necessary documents (above 1-6) in order and make it a completed application package (1 PDF file); then, send to your university coordinator.

ex. PDF file title: 2017 Spring Incoming Exchange Application_ First Name + Last Name

5. *The university coordinator may help to send the completed package to **Ms. Katie Lai** jhlaic@nctu.edu.tw via **email only** in one time before **15th Oct., 2016** (incomplete or late application will not be considered).
6. Students can log in to the application system and check your status in Dec., 2016. Once you are qualified, we will send "Letter of admission" to each student (mid Dec., 2016) via email and you may confirm your enrollment status as well.
7. The "Welcome Package" will be provided via email (please wait till late Dec, 2016).

*Applications will **NOT** be processed until all supporting documents are 1) uploaded on-line and 2) received via email.

*"College of Management" is limited to "Final year undergraduate students and Master or PhD students".

*The course timetable will be finalized before the start of each semester, so students may not get the latest schedule during the application process. However, the timetable of each semester would be similar most of time. Students are able to choose courses all over NCTU, but not all courses. Students are strongly recommended to ask the department or course professor before they enroll to the course.

*The applications and supporting documents would be reviewed by each department. The department

determines the right whether the candidate will be admitted or not. Sometimes, the department may reallocate student to suitable department.

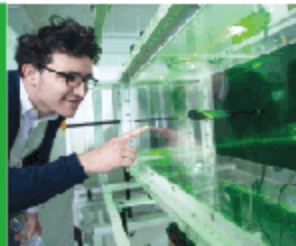

Program Profile

NCTU provides international students a chance to explore exciting overseas study experience and Asian life style. We offer three kinds of exchange programs.

A. Exchange student

1. Students from our partner universities who wish to take courses at NCTU and are nominated by their home universities.
2. Students whose parents are CTU (Hsinchu, Beijing, Shanghai, Xi'an, Southwest Jiaotong University) alumni who wish to take courses at NCTU.

B. Visiting student (fee-paying exchange student)

1. Students from our partner universities who wish to take courses at NCTU without applying via their home universities.
2. Students from non-partner universities who wish to take courses at NCTU.

C. Research student

1. Current students from foreign universities who wish to do research at NCTU.
2. All applicants are to firstly identify a professor at NCTU to be their research supervisor before application.

Documents Required (On-line)

1. Application form
2. Curriculum vitae (CV)
3. Study Plan
4. An original transcript in English
5. A copy of valid student ID card
6. A copy of valid passport

Exchange Programs Offered

NCTU provides nearly 100 programs for exchange studies. Students should specify their desired department or institute to exchange according to their current equivalent degree. Students must visit NCTU website to look for more course information before applying.

Course Selection

Visit <http://timetable.nctu.edu.tw/> for English-medium courses. The course timetable will be finalized before the start of each semester. Students may choose previous semester courses for reference.

Minimum credit requirement (per semester):

- ◆ Undergraduates: 15 credits (senior: 9 credits)
- ◆ Graduates: 2 courses
- ◆ Other credit requirements are subject to individual department or institute students have enrolled.

Division of International & Cross-strait Services (ICS)

ICS is part of the Office of International Affairs and is located on the 1st floor of Administrative Building.

ICS is established to offer on-site service, such as accommodation, insurance, visa, registration for our international students. ICS cooperates with other school units to process course selection and tuition payment as well as providing guidance and assistance for all international students.

On-Site Orientation

Admitted students are encouraged to arrive at NCTU one week prior to the start-date of each semester. ICS will provide orientation, on-campus information and arrange campus tours for newcomers.
