Medical insurance

Are exchange students required to purchase a compulsory medical insurance plan? If yes, please provide details.	No matter that exchange students buy insurance in home country to cover his/her study abroad, Ministry of Education of P. R. China requires that foreign students buy compulsory health insurance at host university in China since 2008. The cost is 400 RMB for one semester.
If no, is purchase of medical insurance recommended?	Purchase of medical insurance in home country as a supplement to Compulsory Medical Insurance is also recommended

Visa Requirements

Are exchange students required to obtain a student visa? If yes, what are the procedures?	Yes. Visa type: X1 or X2. X1 visa – two semester exchange X2 visa – one semester exchange See visa requirements on consulates websites.
Is there any physical examination needed?	Students must do physical examination after enrollment if they stay in mainland China for more than 180 days or if they want multiple entries. Physical exam costs RMB660yuan and Resident Permit costs RMB400yuan. To have a physical examination after enrollment at Fudan is recommended because the verification of home physical examination record will probably fail due to different physical examination system.
Are exchange students allowed to do off-campus internship?	Yes, General Advanced and Senior Advanced students can do off-campus internship, but need to get resident permit with internship remark. Chinese language students are not allowed to do off-campus internship.
