

Checklist for Technion Outgoing Exchange Students

1. Go over the application Procedure: <https://int.technion.ac.il/programs/outgoing/>

2. Technion student wishing to participate in Student Exchange Program:

- Must have a GPA [Grade Point Average] of 80+ for Engineering students, 85+ for Architecture students.
- Must have no disciplinary issues or improper academic status
- Must have completed at least 4 Technion semesters [minimum of 40 academic credit points]
- Must return to Technion for at least 1 semester after the exchange
- Must have a sufficient level of proficiency in English
- Must take one of the courses offered by Technion International in English

3. Submit the following materials through the Technion International online application system:

- In the application Form - make sure to name 5 optional Host Universities and arrange the list by priority.
- If applying to the GE3 scheme, please choose only 1 GE3 university from the list (if you are chosen for the scheme you will then be able to choose 3 options for GE3 universities)
- Faculty approval form – signed by the academic advisor at your home faculty
- Updated transcript in English
- Resume (CV) in English
- Letter of Intent: Explain your goals for studies at foreign university; illustrate your competence to represent Technion.
- Proof of English proficiency level – obtained by the Humanities department

4. Payments and fees:

- Tuition is paid regularly to the Technion.
- One time non-refundable 190 NIS charge for application, charged through regular tuition.
- 300 NIS for late application
- 300 NIS – cancellation fee BEFORE contact with Host University.
- 650 NIS – cancellation fee AFTER contact with Host University.

5. Dates:

- Application deadline for the Technion student exchange program:
- Application deadline for engineering and sciences: **December 6th, 2020.**
- Application deadline for architecture: **December 13th, 2020.**
- TI confirmation of eligibility for studies in a foreign university – January 2021.

Final decision is made by the host university.

6. Upon return from the exchange program: students will need to transfer their transcript to their home faculty to request the credit transfer. The home faculty's decision will be based on transcript and course syllabi.

IMPORTANT NOTES!
